Instructions for *dependent* students:

List the people in *your parent's* family. Include:

- Yourself and your parent(s) (including a stepparent) even if you don't live with your parents – If your parents are currently separated or divorced, then list only the parent whose information you provided on the FAFSA.
- Your parents' other children, even if they do not live with your parent(s), if (a) your parents will provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027, or (b) the children would be required to provide parent information on the FAFSA.
- Other people if they now live with your parents and your parents provide more than half of their support and will continue to provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027.

Instructions for *independent* students:

List the people in *your* family. Include:

- Yourself and your spouse. If you are currently separated from your spouse, then do not list your spouse.
- Your children (if you and your spouse will provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027. Include all of your children who meet this standard, even if they do not live with you.
- Other people living with you if you and your spouse provide more than half of their support and will continue to provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027.

Number in College:

Any family member who will be enrolled at least half-time in a degree, diploma or certificate program at an eligible postsecondary institution between July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027. Include the name of the college. To determine your family size for the 2026-2027 FAFSA, think about who you could claim as dependents on your taxes if you were filing one right now. Since unborn children can't be claimed as dependents, they shouldn't be included in your family size for the FAFSA.
